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Abstract: This contribution proposes to abandon Draft New Recommendation ITU-T Y.2086 (formerly Y.DNI-fr): "Framework and Requirements of Decentralized Trustworthy Network Infrastructure".¹

ARIN thanks ITU-T SG13, the authors and contributors for the opportunity to provide comments regarding next steps for Y.2086.

Draft Recommendation Y.2086 went to last call over four years ago. Consequently, many of us have spent a great number of resources on this recommendation. ARIN submitted a contribution² in 2023 which raised concerns that have not been addressed. It is our belief that Y.2086 lacks the clarity and full development necessary to be an ITU Recommendation. Given both the length of time that this recommendation has been in last call and the lack of need for this effort as demonstrated by the insufficient urgency to resolve the issues necessary to approve this recommendation, it is clear this recommendation is not needed. ARIN supports stopping work on this recommendation and deleting this work item.
