AC Role in the PDP

1. Work with author on proposals to ensure clarity and valid problem statement
2. Work on Draft Policies
 - Gather input from the community and present to community
3. Move to Recommended Draft Policies once they are:
 - Fair and impartial
 - Technically sound
 - Supported by community
4. Recommend for adoption, present to the community
5. Send to Last Call and review comments
6. Recommend to the Board of Trustees

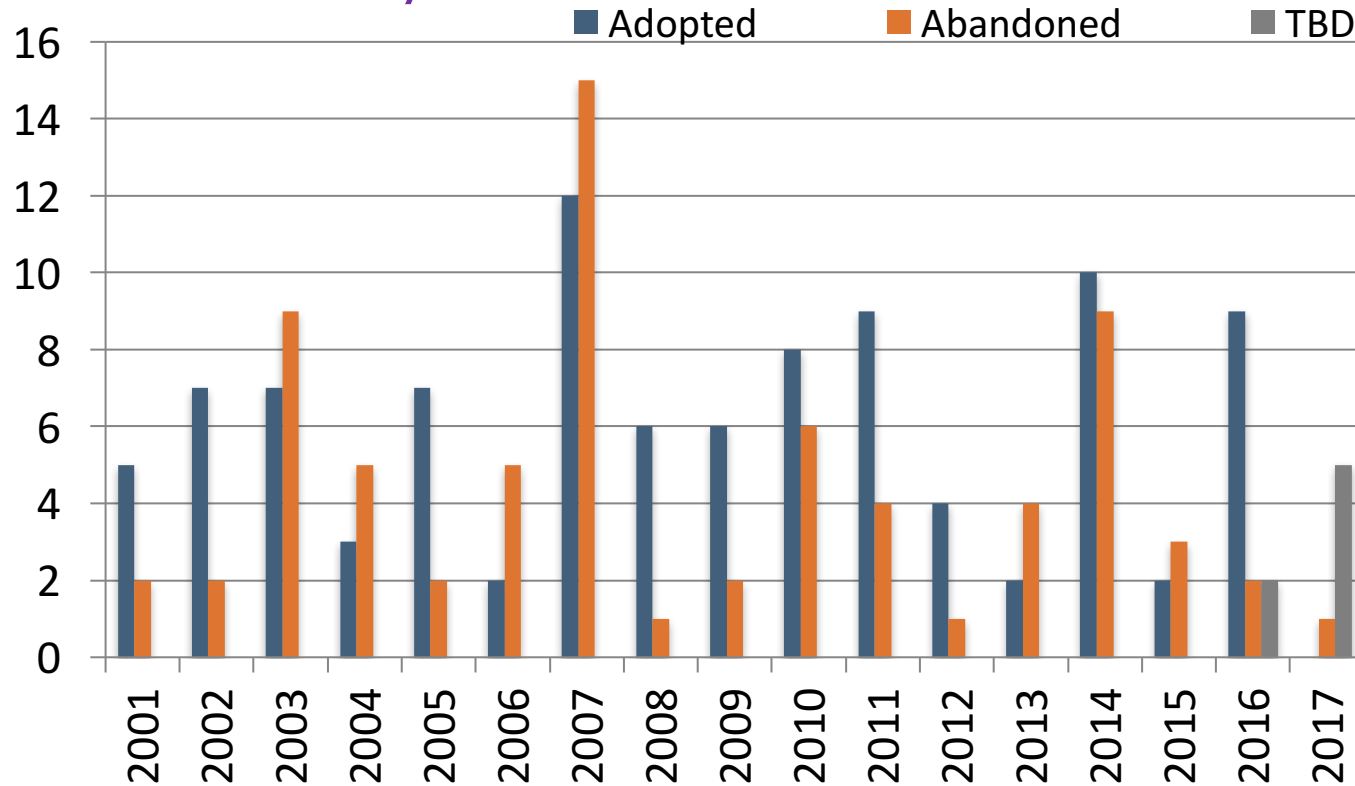
Policy Work since ARIN 38

- Sent to the Board of Trustees for Adoption:
 - ARIN-2015-2: Modify 8.4 (Inter-RIR Transfers to Specified Recipients)
 - ARIN-2016-1: Reserved Pool Transfer Policy
 - ARIN-2016-2: Change timeframes for IPv4 requests to 24 months
 - ARIN-2016-4: Transfers for new entrants
 - ARIN-2016-5: Post-IPv4-Free-Pool-Depletion Transfer Policy
 - ARIN-2016-6: Eliminate HD-Ratio from NRPM
- 2016-2 to be implemented by 29 June, all others adopted and implemented by ARIN staff

Policy Work since ARIN 38 (continued)

- Abandoned:
 - Recommended Draft Policy ARIN-2015-7: Simplified requirements for demonstrated need for IPv4 transfers
 - Draft Policy ARIN-2016-7: Integration of Community Networks into existing ISP policy
- Eight New Proposals
 - Four Advanced to Draft Policy Status
 - Two Advanced to Recommended Draft Policy Status
 - Two being worked on for clarity and understanding
- 2 Public Policy Meetings (PPMs)
- Current docket: 8 items (Two RDPs, Four DPs, Two Proposals)
