ITHI - What is it?



- Goal of ITHI is to measure developed metrics designed to track the health of the Internet's unique identifier systems
- Regional Internet Registries (RIRs) have developed metrics for the Internet Number Registry System
- Initial metrics have been approved by the Number Resource Organization (NRO)
- Initial measurements are in process by each of the RIRs

SCOPE - What is included?



•All Internet number resources (INRs) administered by each RIR and included in the NRO extended delegated statistics

 Specifically excluded are those INRs reserved by IANA for the technical community, special purposes, and future delegation

Metrics - Comprehensive



- •To be COMPREHENSIVE, there are two criteria:
 - Complete all INRs administered by each RIR are accounted for in the NRO extended delegated statistics
 - Unique no duplicates of INRs are contained in the NRO extended delegated statistics

 Global measurement performed by the RIPE NCC


Metrics - Comprehensive



- •Do INRs registered by ARIN have a required POC with an email address?
- •Do INRs registered by ARIN have the required Organization's legal name and street address?
- Local measurement performed by ARIN

Number Comprehensive






Metrics - Correct



- Required registration data listed for organizations that hold INRs must match official sources, and must be marked as "Vetted" in the ARIN database
- Required contact (POC) data listed for the INR holder must be functional and reachable, and must be marked as "Validated" in the ARIN database
- Local measurement performed by ARIN

Number Correct






Metrics - Current



- Required registration data listed for organizations that hold INRs must have been confirmed as up-to-date or updated in past 5 years
- Required contact (POC) data listed for the INR holder must be have been confirmed as up-todate or updated in the past 5 years
