Removal of Requirement to Demonstrate Utilization of Reassignments and Reallocations for ISPs Seeking Initial Allocation from ARIN

Current Section 4.2.2 Initial Allocations to ISPs

Orgs with Reallocations or Reassignments from Upstream Providers:

- Must show efficient utilization of reallocations and reassignments to qualify to receive up to a /22 under this policy section

Orgs without Reallocations or Reassignments from Upstream Providers:

- Automatically qualify for a /24
- May qualify for a larger direct assignment or allocation without showing efficient utilization of previous space.

Problem Statement

- The current text of 4.2.2 places a higher burden on organizations that already have space from an upstream provider.
- Organizations without prior holdings from an upstream provider may be able to get on ARIN's waitlist sooner than organizations who have to put together documentation to show efficient utilization.
- This may create an unfair advantage for new companies with no prior space.

Proposed Text

Replace 4.2.2 with the following:

4.2.2. Initial Allocation to ISPs

All ISP organizations automatically qualify for a /24. These organizations may qualify for more than a /24 by documenting how the requested allocation will be utilized within the request size specified in 4.2.4.3.

ISP organizations without direct assignments or allocations from ARIN qualify for an initial allocation of up to a /22, subject to ARIN's minimum allocation size.
