# What Do We Do?

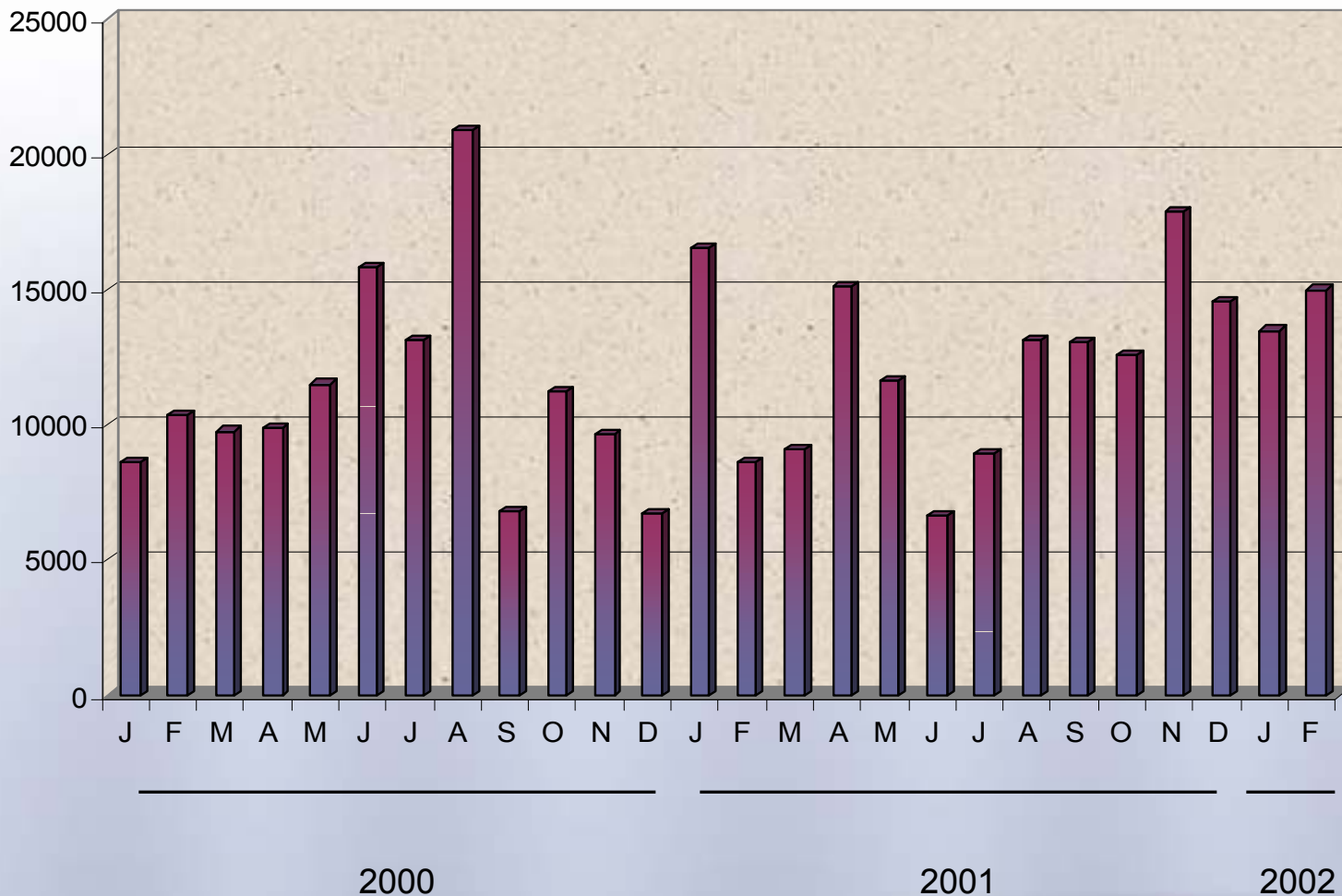
- ④ Analyze and Process Requests for:
  - ④ IPv4 address space
  - ④ IPv6 address space
  - ④ Autonomous System numbers
  - ④ IP and ASN Transfers
- ④ Maintain WHOIS by Processing:
  - ④ SWIP reassignment templates
  - ④ Network and ASN Modification templates
- ④ Maintain ARIN Routing Registry
- ④ Operate ARIN Help Desk
  - ④ Telephonic (7am-7pm)
  - ④ Hostmaster@arin.net

# What's New?

- Ⓢ Response time is less than 2 days (usually same day)
- Ⓢ Finalized new templates (RSD to begin beta testing)
- Ⓢ Updating stale POC data in WHOIS (when notified)
- Ⓢ Receiving many AUPs/requests for bulk copies of WHOIS (Policy 2001-7 implemented in mid-Feb)
- Ⓢ Continue to participate in training development
- Ⓢ Transfers increasing (bankruptcies, mergers, acquisitions)
- Ⓢ LACNIC training/second opinion (on-going coordination)

# IPv4



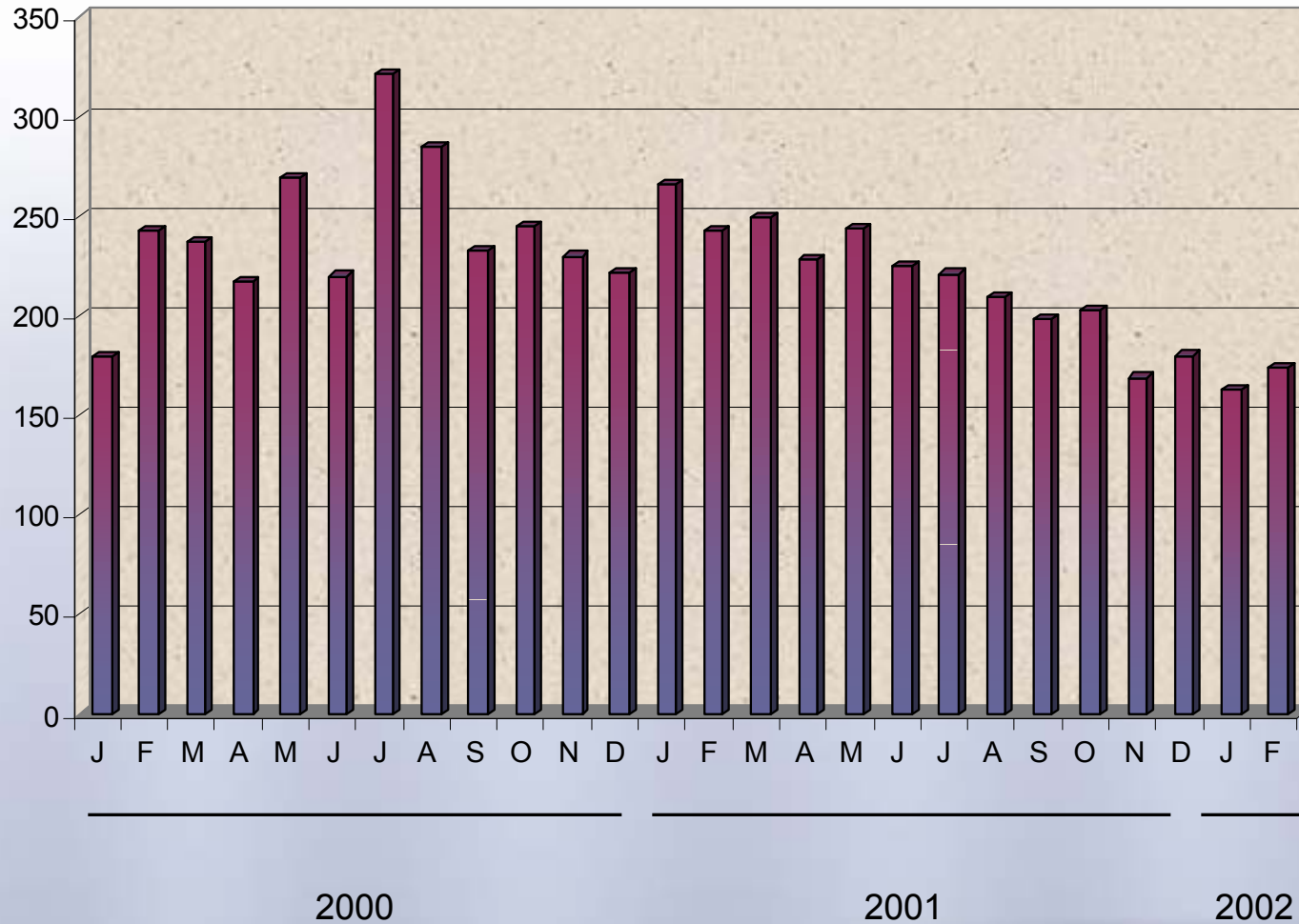
1.29 /8s in 1999

# AS Numbers



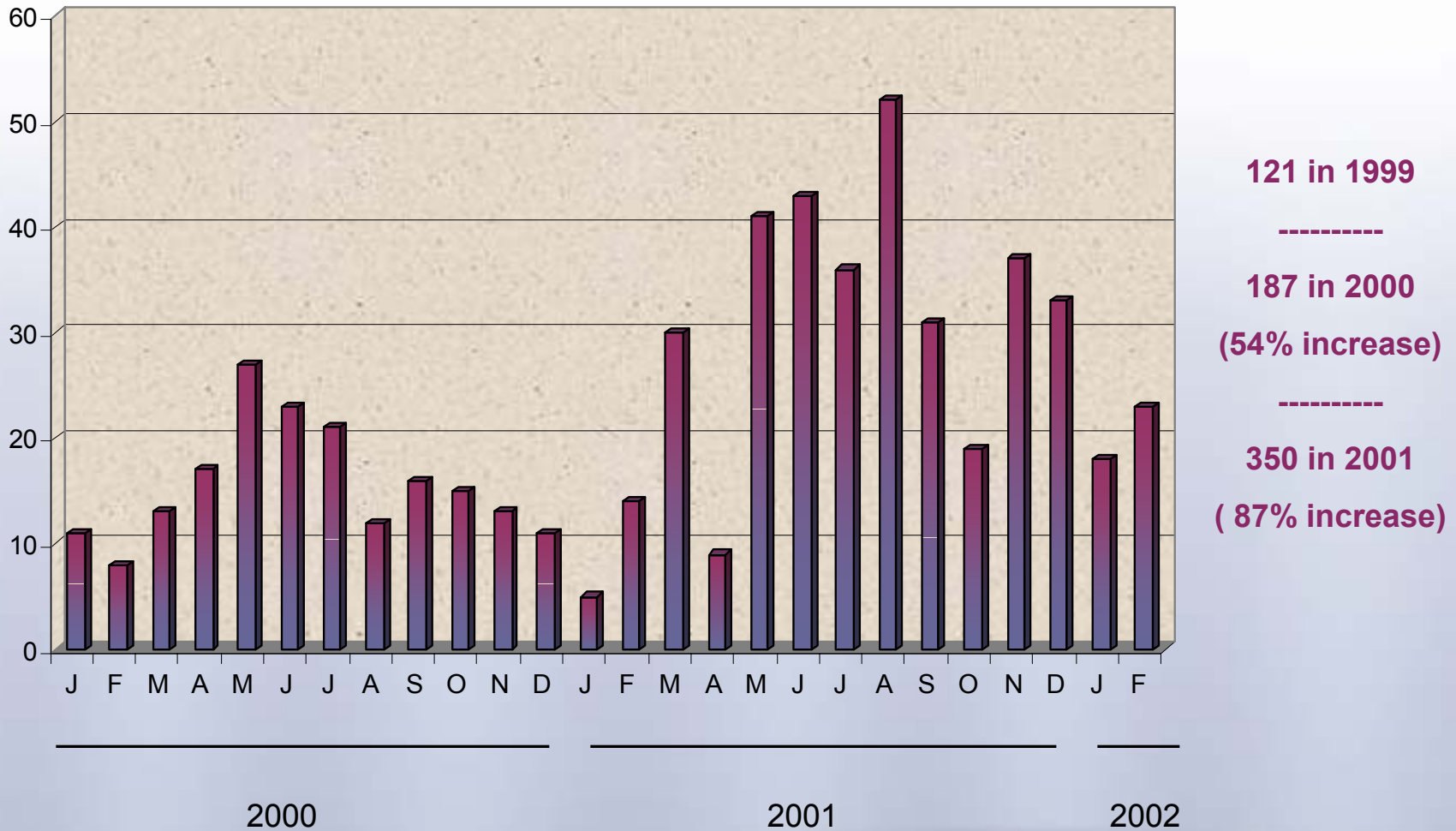
1,685 in 1999

- ④ 6 Mexico, 1 Canada, 1 Brazil, 19 USA
