Staff Impact Analysis

- ✦ NRPM Section – 4.1.8 (new) and 4.3.5 (unchanged)
- ✦ Present - End-users are encouraged to make use of RFC 1918 space when not connected to the Internet
- ✦ Change - “Private networks may obtain global addresses for private network usage.”
- ✦ Departments reported no significant operational impact, except for Registration Services:
 - ▶ This policy may produce a large increase in requests for IP address space which would generate additional work-load. ARIN would then need to request IP address space more frequently from the IANA.
