# Recent policy discussions

- Applying HD ratio to IPv4
  - Given 4 week comments, 14 April expiry
  - Decision to abandon or carry this fwd
- 4 byte ASN policy proposal endorsed at APNIC 21
  - Final comment period, 12 May expiry

[prop-027-v001]	The second phase of large space IPv4 trial usage program for future IPv6 deployment	Implemented
[prop-030-v002]	Deprecation of ip6.in reverse DNS service in APNIC	Implementation 1/6/2006
[prop-031-v002]	Proposal to amend APNIC IPv6 assignment and utilisation requirement policy	Changing HD ratio to 0.94 was endorsed by EC. Implementation subject to other regions
