Overhauling section 4.6

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- Unused IPv4 addresses and legacy addresses are prime targets for abuse.
- IPv6 uptake will actually worsen the abuse problem for unused IPv4 space

Section 4.6 continued

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- Free space garbage collection is hard.
- We should make it as easy as possible and provide some carrots for doing so.

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- IPv6 carrots are one possible way to reach out to legacy holders and entice them into the ARIN process

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- Fees aren't a policy matter.
- This proposal suggests that the BOT consider fee-based carrots, but, fee issues can't be part of policy.

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- ARIN has very few sticks at its disposal.
- Sticks are not likely to have a positive effect anyway.
- Discussion of sticks has already done some harm on PPML.
- 9 out of 10 rabbits respond better to carrots than sticks.
