POLICY PROPOSAL 2007-17 Understanding

Replaces the existing amnesty policy in NRPM Section 4.6.

- ARIN currently chooses the replacement network. The proposal would allow the resource holder to choose either to retain a portion of the returned space or get new address space.
- Yearly contact, marking "unreachable", and reclamation.
- Return timeframe changed from 12 months to 6 to 18 months plus one extension.
- If you use this policy and later you request new space, RSA will apply to retained space.
- Suggests BoT consider incentives.

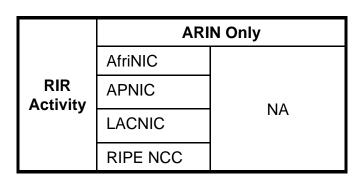
