POLICY PROPOSAL 2008-2

Discussion

Denver (123 people in the room)

- "Should ARIN continue work on a relaxed transfer policy?" -- **49 in favor** and **7 against**.
- "Should policy retain a need based qualification?" – **54 in favor** and **3 against**.
- "Assuming policy retains a need based qualification, should the policy take effect sooner than depletion of the IANA free pool?" -- **35 in favor** and **13 against**.

Kingston (52 people in the room)

- "Work towards a new transfer policy" – **25 in favor** and **3 against**.
- "Should it be needs based?" – **32 in favor** and **0 against**.
