POLICY PROPOSAL 2008-3

Revised Yesterday

From “non-profit” to specific criteria

- Community Network
 - Staff must be at least half volunteers
 - Annual revenue less than \$250,000
- Legal responsibility for the network
 - Non-profit organization
 - Or fiscally sponsored by non-profit or a university

POLICY PROPOSAL 2008-3

Discussion

Denver (129 people in the room)

- "Support 2008-3" - **4 in favor** and **40 against**.
- "Should the AC abandon the proposal?" – **17 in favor** and **34 against**.

Kingston (40 people in the room)

- "Support as is" – **2 in favor** and **0 against**.
- "AC should continue to work on the proposal" – **21 in favor** and **0 against**.
