

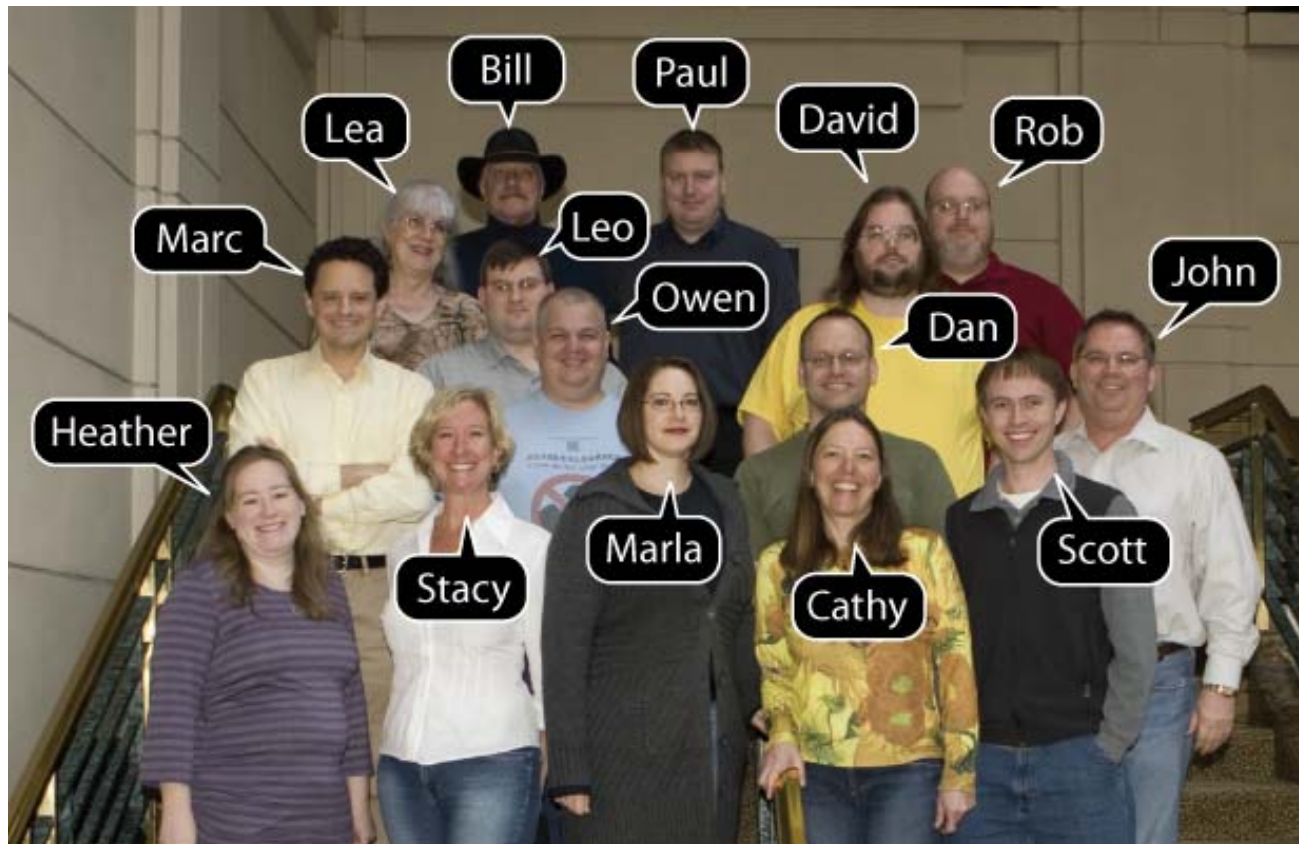

Role in the Policy Development Process

1. AC assigns shepherds to policy proposals and evaluates policy proposals.
2. AC develops and evaluates draft policies.
3. AC presents draft policies at Public Policy Meetings.
4. AC determines community consensus.
5. AC recommends draft policy it supports to the Board of Trustees for adoption.
